Minimum GPA	GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent in other grading systems)	
Japanese language requirements	At least one year (≈300 hours) of Japanese study at an educational institution (i.e. students have Japanese language skills equivalent to JLPT N5 and aiming for JLPT N4).	
Qualification	Applicants should complete at least 1 semester of study at home university by the time of nomination.	
Exchange period	One semester / One academic year

Application procedure	Applications must be submitted to the home university's exchange coordinator. The coordinator is asked to send all documents to Seikei University by email.

Faculties	Economics, Business Administration, Science and Technology, Humanities, Law, Faculty of Global Studies and Sustainability (Undergraduate and graduate school)
Areas of study open to exchange students	<u>In principle, exchange students take Japanese language courses mainly here at Seikei University.</u> Students may take academic courses with the instructor's permission, but enrollment is not guaranteed.
Courses <u>NOT</u> open to exchange students	Courses of Physical Education, Teacher Training and some of the courses with limited enrollment are not open to the exchange students.
Minimum required classes per semester	Students are required to take minimum 6 classes per semester to keep their student visa status.
Language of instruction	Most courses are offered in Japanese, with only a few taught in English.
Other language courses	Other language classes are an option depending on space availability and level of ability. (German, French, Spanish, Chinese, Korean and Thai)

The annual number of recipients is 60 students. ➤ Kumiko Fukaya International Scholarship ¥60,000/ month for up to 10 months. The Outstanding student, 1 applicant per semester. <p>The recipients of the scholarships must take part actively in the exchange program events with Seikei University students, and cooperate during activities and publicity events organized by Seikei Institute for International Studies (SIIS).</p> <p>*The Seikei Scholarship and scholarships from other organizations can be combined, provided that the total amount of the Seikei Scholarship and scholarships from other organizations does not exceed 100,000 yen.</p>
