放送問題 I -A

今からペットショップでトカゲ科の生き物 (lizards) についての説明を聞いてもらいます。説明を聞き、1～5が内容と同じ場合はT、異なる場合はFを○で囲みなさい。

今から1～5を読み上げます。

1. Lizards need to take a bath every day.
2. Bearded dragons are active at night.
3. Geckos like to stay in a warm place.
4. Iguanas are very safe for humans.
5. Chameleons live for about twenty years.

\* Good afternoon. Welcome to ABC Pet Shop. I heard you are interested in lizards as pets. OK, I will explain about lizards.

First, lizards may be good pets because most of them are small and easy to take care of. They are usually quiet, and they do not need to go for walks or take baths.

Next, I will tell you about two popular lizards. One of them is the bearded dragon. Bearded dragons are active during the day. The other one is the gecko. Geckos are a little more difficult to take care of because they are active at night and need a warm place to live. Both of these lizards can live for ten years or more and you can hold them.

Finally, I will tell you two bad choices for pets. They are the iguana and the chameleon. Iguanas usually become almost two meters long, so they need a big space to live in. They may also hurt people. Iguanas can live for about twenty years, but chameleons do not live more than five years.

So, what do you think? Please think for a while and decide which lizard you want to have.
