Well, I think many people have experienced the same kind of trouble. It's not only you, so don't worry. Here is some advice.

First, you should not think of yourself as the center of the world. It is important to see things from different *points of view. Perhaps you only think about yourself and push your way of thinking on other people without listening. If you only think about your own *interests, you may be *successful. However, this is very *selfish and you will be all alone because you are always helped by people around you. Without any help from other people, your life will be more difficult.

Second, you need to understand the characters and the situations of other people. For example, when you work or talk with other people, you should put yourself in their *position or find a common *topic you can talk about. You should be interested in them and think about their feelings. Of course, you need to tell them about your situation if it is necessary. The balance of listening and speaking is important.

Third, people have different ways of thinking and different ideas. This is called a *lifestyle. Different people have different lifestyles. Because of this, people sometimes do not agree with your way of thinking. We are all different. People have their own lifestyles. Your thinking and other people's way of thinking are different.

Your problem is not easy to solve, but please don't give up. We are connected with each other. I know you will find a way.
