

Seven members of the family were moving together to the south. The mother stayed close to her youngest baby because it was smaller than \*average, but very \*curious and active. The baby sometimes swam by itself, far away from its family. It didn't know that the big ocean was very dangerous.

On the way to the south, the orca family passed near Hokkaido. \*Floating ice gathers on the \*shore of Shiretoko from the middle of January every year, and it already started gathering that year, too. The baby orca saw floating ice for the first time. It was very interesting, so the baby orca began to follow it. It swam after the floating ice. It kept following the ice until it was far away from its mother and family. Now the baby orca was alone, but it didn't stop. The baby swam to the shore until it was very close. Then, it couldn't move. A lot of ice was along the shore. The baby was \*trapped in the \*thick and heavy ice. It was afraid and \*called for its mother many times.

The orca family started looking for the lost baby. They swam around, and then they heard the baby's voice. They hurried to the shore and found the baby among the heavy ice. The baby was trying hard to \*get out of it. The family reached the baby and surrounded it. They tried to encourage and save it. They tried and tried, but they became trapped in the floating ice, too. Now all of the family members were trapped.

The people on the shore found the orca family and tried to \*free them from the ice. The people could lead the orcas away from the shore but not the baby orca. So, the family members swam back to the baby. The people tried again and again, but they could not help the orca family and the baby. The orcas became weaker

and weaker, and \*breathing became difficult for them. The orcas stopped moving little by little. The people couldn't do anything for them. A few days later, they found all the orcas dead.
